



Certified Nursing Assistant

The Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) works under the general direction of the RN (RN) and the Clinical Manager (CM). The CNA serves as a member of the Interdisciplinary Team (IDT) and provides personal care services consistent with the care plan and is responsible for provision of services consistent with the mission, vision, and goals of HWC, quality outcomes and regulatory standards.

The Certified Nursing Assistant will be responsible for demonstrating the ability to care for patient by performing personal care skills and services; providing emotional support and compassionate care to the patient and family; demonstrating ability to assist patient with ambulation/transfer activities; demonstrating knowledge of safety measures related to caring for the patient and demonstrating an understanding of and follows the CNA care plan.
