



Clinical Chaplain

The Clinical Chaplain works under the general direction of the Spiritual Care Manager. The Clinical Chaplain serves as a member of the Interdisciplinary Team and is responsible for coordinating spiritual care services, provision of services consistent with the mission, vision, and goals of HWC, quality outcomes and regulatory standards.

The Clinical Chaplain performs and documents spiritual care assessments on every newly enrolled hospice patient and assists in the development and implementation of the Plan of Care in accordance with the HWC standards and provides ongoing spiritual support and/or counsel to patients/families in keeping with their beliefs as outlined in the patients POC..
