



Crisis Care Licensed Practical Nurse

The Crisis Care Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) works under the general direction of the Crisis Care Manager. The Crisis Care LPN serves as a member of the interdisciplinary team (IDT) and provides patient care consistent with the Plan of Care (POC) and is responsible for provision of services consistent with the mission, vision, and goals of HWC, quality outcomes and regulatory standards.

The Crisis Care Licensed Practical Nurse will be responsible for monitoring conditions of patients and provides symptom management and treatments per orders and care plan; providing support during Continuous Care under the supervision of the Crisis Care Manager; performing specific assignments as directed by the Crisis Care Manager or designee; informing Crisis Care Manager of unusual or potentially problematic patient/caregiver issues as identified; reporting any changes in the patient's condition or family situation to the Crisis Care Manager and RNCM; communicating with attending physicians, HWC staff members, and other agencies as necessary to coordinate optimal care and use of resources for patients/caregivers.
