



Licensed Practical Nurse

The Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) works under the general direction of the Registered Nurse (RN), Clinical Manager (CM), Medical Director, and physician. The LPN serves as a member of the interdisciplinary team (IDT) and provides patient care consistent with the Plan of Care (POC) and is responsible for provision of services consistent with the mission, vision, and goals of HWC, quality outcomes and regulatory standards.

The Licensed Practical Nurse will be responsible for assisting RNCM's with their patient assignments as needs are identified; communicating with attending physicians, HWC staff members, and other agencies as necessary to coordinate optimal care and use of resources for patients/caregivers; educating patients/caregivers regarding hospice philosophy, disease progression, physical components of care, stages of dying, and other aspects of the POC as necessary.
