



Registered Nurse Case Manager

The Registered Nurse Case Manager (RNCM) works under the general direction of the Patient Care Manager (PCM), The RNCM serves as a member of the Interdisciplinary Team (IDT) and coordinates patient care consistent with the Plan of Care (POC) and is responsible for provision of services consistent with the mission, vision, and goals of HWC, quality outcomes and regulatory standards.

The Registered Nurse Case Manager will be responsible for communicating with attending physicians, HWC staff members, and other agencies as necessary to coordinate optimal care and use of resources for patients/caregivers; educating patients/caregivers regarding hospice philosophy, disease progression, physical components of care, stages of dying, and other aspects of the POC as necessary; regularly attending and participating in IDT meetings to ensure that the POC reflects current patient care needs and conducting CNA supervisory visits per regulatory standards.
